Introduction to Sewing: Part 2

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

For those of you who have taken the Intro to Sewing part 1, here is the next usage class to help you gain even more skills and confidence. In this class you will learn about a variety of hems, seam techniques to make your projects look professional, the proper way to sew a dart, and how to make beautiful buttonholes.

You must understand how to use your machine (threading, bobbins, changing feet, etc.), and have basic understanding of threads, tensions, needles, and fabric. If you took the Intro to Sewing 1, then you are all set. Class STARTS at 10 AM, please arrive early to set up and be ready to sew by 10.

YOUR SUPPLY LIST (WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING):

- Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget your power cord and foot control)
- All feet and accessories that came with your machine, including bobbins. Make sure to bring your buttonhole foot and blind hem foot, most machines include these.
- All tools (especially your **screwdrivers**) that came with your machine
- Other optional feet that will be very useful: Open toe foot, edge joining foot
- Sewing Machine Manual. If you do not have one, you should be able to find one on-line.
- New sewing Machine Needles, universal 80 or 90 are fine
- Seam gauge
- Small **sharp** scissors for clipping threads and fabric
- Pins
- Good quality sewing thread
- Machine cleaning brush or other cleaning tool
- Pencil and paper to take notes
- Non-messy Snacks if needed
