Quilter's 12 Pocket Tote Bag

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

In class you may make the size bag you need - see the supply list - large, medium or small. I would suggest doing the large size in class. Once you make one (1) bag in class the other sizes will be very easy to make at home. Each size will have 12 pockets to carry your supplies and quilts or the things for the beach, groceries or whatever you need a tote bag for. Can even be used as a purse and will be shown in class. This tote bag has all kinds of uses.

YOUR SUPPLY LIST (WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING):

- Sewing machine in good working order (with accessories that came with the machine)*
- Jeans/denim sewing machine needles,*
- Seam ripper, sharp*
- Small scissors or thread snips*
- Sharp scissors*
- Sharp pins, glass headed are best, or clips*
- Good quality Thread to match/blend with fabrics*
- Fabric marking pen/chalk to mark fabric*
- Other sewing notions that you love to sew with (like glasses)
- Fabrics and zippers*
 - For the **LARGE** tote:
 - 3 yard of 54 inch wide fabric
 - 4 yards of 1inch wide nylon strap
 - 26 inch separating zipper
 - For the **MEDIUM** tote:
 - 3 yard of 45 inch wide fabric
 - 4 yards of 1 inch wide nylon strap
 - 18 inch separating zipper
 - For the **SMALL** tote:
 - 2.5 yard of 45 inch wide fabric
 - 4 yards of 1 inch wide nylon strap
 - 16 inch separating zipper
- Extra full bobbins*
- Rotary cutters and rulers will be available at the store for your use
