



5 Chic & Quick Zipper Bags

Teacher: Lois Davila

Level: Confident Beginner

(Comfortable using rotary cutter, ruler, and mat)

Supplies for Class: *(Instruction will focus on the Medium & Large size bags – your choice!)*

- Pattern: **5 Chic & Quick Toiletry Bags**
- Fabric: 2 fat quarters (1 for outer bag and 1 for lining)
- Zipper: 18" or longer
- Stabilizers: Fusible fleece (1/2 yd) **and** Shapeflex 101 (1/2 yd)
- 505 Temporary adhesive spray
- Threads to match fabrics and zipper
- Sewing Machine, manual, universal foot, quarter inch foot
- Extension table (very helpful!)
- Microtex 80/12 machine needles
- Pattern-Ease (1 yard) for tracing templates (optional)
- 45mm rotary cutter, mat, and rulers: 6 x 24 **and** 6 x 12
- Iron (with steam) and wool mat
- A good pair of sharp scissors
- Marking tools: Frixion pen, Chacoliner or equivalent
- Wonder clips (red)
- Flat-headed pins and a Stylus (also very helpful!)
- Dritz Quick Turn Fabric Tube Turners

Class Preparation: *(CLASS WILL BEGIN WITH FUSING & QUILTING)*

1. Choose either the **Medium or Large** Template. Cut out the paper template **OR** trace template **with all markings** onto Pattern-Ease.
2. Iron both ***fat quarters.

If you choose to make the **Medium** bag, cut from each of the fat quarters and both stabilizers, 1 - 16" x 16" square.

If you choose to make the **Large** bag, cut from each of the fat quarters and both stabilizers, 1 - 18" x 18" square.

***If you choose a "directional" fabric, refer to page 6 of pattern "Using 1-way fabric.
