

Camden Bowls

Add something special to your home décor with beautiful, stitched baskets using the **Camden Bowls** pattern by Aunties Two. Great for any holiday!!! Instruction will focus on making sturdy, stiff tubes with double-sided fusible batting to create the walls (sides) of the bowl as well as how to attach a structured bottom. Turn your “bowl” into a “gift box” with a lid!!

Class Supply List to make SMALL (size) Camden Bowl

Important NOTE: To make the best use of class time, we will construct the “small” size bowl – to work through the complete the “bowl-making process!”

- Pattern: **Camden Bowls** by Aunties Two Patterns
- Fabric: an assortment of 2 ½” x WOF strips (5-6 would be great!)
and an additional ¾ yard for bottom and binding
- Interfacing for TUBES: *(1 roll makes 3+ bowls!)*
Bosal Duet-Fuse II on a Roll - Double Sided **Fusible** (2 ¼” x 25 yards)
- Interfacing for BOTTOM:
1 pkg. **Bosal Craf-Tex** Double -Sided Fusible Plus (SMALL) Circle
- Matching threads: 50 wt. Aurifil or Mettler work well!
- Parchment paper
- Dritz Thermal Thimbles (optional)
- Sewing machine with Microtex 80/12 and 90/14 needles
- **Sturdy, sharp pins and Wonder Clips (red)**
- Hand-sewing needle (strongly recommend Milliners needles - available @ Scrap & Sew)
- Colorful Crafting Buttons – available @ Scrap & Sew!
- General sewing supplies: rotary cutter, ruler, scissors, seam ripper, marking tools
- **ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL “LID” supplies:**
Fabric strips (3 -4) 2 ½” x WOF
½ yard coordinating fabric
1 pkg. **Bosal** Craf-Tex DOUBLE SIDED PLUS 20” x 36”
Tool for drawing circles: **Creative Grids “Quick Trim Ruler”** or a compass!
