(Comfortable with your sewing machine and binding a project.)

Class Supply List to make SMALL (size) Camden Bowl

Important NOTE: To make the best use of class time, we will construct the "small" size bowl – to work through the complete the "bowl-making process!"

- Pattern: **Camden Bowls** by Aunties Two Patterns
- Fabric: an assortment of 2 ½" x WOF strips (6 - 8 would be great!) and additional 1/2 yard for bottom and binding
- Interfacing for TUBES:
Bosal Duet-Fuse II on a Roll - Double Sided **Fusible Batting**
2 ¼" x 20 yards (*1 roll makes 3+ small bowls!*)
- Interfacing for BOTTOM:
1 pkg. **Bosal Craf-Tex** Double - Sided Fusible Plus (SMALL) Circle
- Matching threads: 50 wt. Aurifil or Mettler work well!
- Parchment paper
- Dritz Thermal Thimbles (optional)
- Sewing machine, manual, universal presser foot. and ¼" presser foot
- Microtex 80/12 and 90/14 needles
- **Sturdy, sharp pins and 2 Wonder Clips (large/green)**
- Hand-sewing needle (strongly recommend Milliners needles - available @ Scrap & Sew)
- Colorful Crafting Buttons – available @ Scrap & Sew! (optional)
- General sewing supplies: rotary cutter, ruler, scissors, seam ripper, marking tools
