(Comfortable using rotary cutter, ruler)

Create some beautiful table décor with a fun “Quilt As You Go” technique! Just in time for upcoming holidays and the gift-giving season! Makes a beautiful table runner or set of placemats...and more! So many possibilities! 😊

Supplies for class:

- **Pattern** – **Jelly Roll Jiggle** – Tiger Lily Press
- **Fabric**
 - Theme/focal fabric – 1/3 yard
 - 12 – 2 ½” Fabric Strips (Jelly Roll strips)
 - Backing – ¾ yard
 - Binding – ½ yard
- **Fusible Fleece** – ½ yard
- **Woven Cotton fusible stabilizer** – 1 ¼ yards (Cali Del or SF 101)
- **Thread:** Variety of colors to complement your fabrics
- 45mm rotary cutter
- 6 ½” x 24 ½” quilting ruler
- 18” x 24” cutting mat
- Sharp scissors (ex. Karen Buckley, Kai)
- Pins and Wonder clips
- Glue stick (optional but useful)
- Marking tools to make sharp lines – permanent and erasable needed
- **Sewing Machine with manual, ¼” sewing foot, regular sewing foot, bobbins**
- **Size 80/12 Microtex Needles**
- Your favorite sewing tools and notions

Prior to class:

- **Press your fabrics prior to class** using Best Press or starch.
- Cut backing fabric (18” x WOF). Fuse to Fusible Fleece
- Bring a snack or lunch...get ready for a fun day!
