Create some beautiful table décor with a fun "Quilt As You Go" technique! Just in time for upcoming holidays and the gift-giving season! Makes a beautiful table runner or set of placemats...and more! So many possibilities! \circ

Supplies for class:

- Pattern Jelly Roll Jiggle Tiger Lily Press
- Fabric

Theme/focal fabric – 1/3 yard

12 – 2 ½" Fabric Strips (Jelly Roll strips)

Backing $-\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Binding – ½ yard

- Fusible Fleece ½ yard
- Woven Cotton fusible stabilizer 1 ¼ yards (Cali Del or SF 101
- Thread: Variety of colors to complement your fabrics
- 45mm rotary cutter
- 6 ½" x 24 ½" quilting ruler
- 18" x 24" cutting mat
- Sharp scissors (ex. Karen Buckley, Kai)
- Pins and Wonder clips
- Glue stick (optional but useful)
- Marking tools to make sharp lines permanent and erasable needed
- Sewing Machine with manual, 1/4" sewing foot, regular sewing foot, bobbins
- Size 80/12 Microtex Needles
- Your favorite sewing tools and notions

Prior to class:

- Press your fabrics prior to class using Best Press or starch.
- Cut backing fabric (18" x WOF). Fuse to Fusible Fleece
- Bring a snack or lunch...get ready for a fun day!
