



NEW! Camden Bowls - Intermediate
Class will focus on creative ways to embellish basket bottom, how to add handles, and a lid! **Read supply list for important pre-class work.**

Important Preparation for Class:

Assemble the “wall” for your Camden Bowl. Trim and bind the “short” ends as taught in *Camden Bowls – Beginner class* OR bind as described on page 4 of the Camden Bowls pattern. (Your choice: small, medium, or large size bowl.)

Class Supply List

- **Pattern:** Camden Bowls by Aunties Two Patterns
- **Fabric:**
 - BOTTOM: ½ yard matching or coordinating fabric
 - LID: An assortment of 2 ½” x WOF strips (4 -5) and an additional ¾ yard coordinating fabric for TOP and HANDLES
- **Interfacing:**
 - BOTTOM: 1 pkg. **Bosal Craf-Tex** Double- Sided Fusible Plus (small, medium, or large circles)
 - TUBES for the LID: **Bosal Duet-Fuse II** on a Roll - (2 ¼” x 20 yds.) Double Sided Polyester **Fusible Batting**
 - LID (TOP): 1 pkg. CRAF-TEX Plus (Double-Sided Fusible) Craft Pack (20” x 36”)
- **Creative Grids Quick Trim Ruler** (3 ½” x 12 ½”)
- **Happy Handles Kit** by Aunties Two (for “structured” handle – optional)
- Dritz Quick Turn Fabric Tube Turner
- Threads: colors to match, coordinate, and embellish!
- Parchment paper
- Dritz Thermal Thimbles
- Sewing machine, manual, universal presser foot. and ¼” presser foot
- Microtex 80/12 and 90/14 machine needles
- **Sturdy, sharp pins, Wonder Clips** – both red (small) and green (large)
- Hand-sewing needle (strongly recommend Milliners needles)
- Colorful crafting buttons – available @ Scrap & Sew! (optional)
- General sewing supplies: rotary cutter, ruler, scissors, seam ripper, marking tools
