



## Screen Play Tote

Practical and fun! This handy tote is made with screen mesh and fat quarters! Pattern offers 4 sizes. Class will create the **LARGE** size tote.

### Class Supply List

- Pattern: **Screen Play** by Nancy Ota patterns
- Fabric: 4 fat quarters
- Polyester Screen Mesh: 18" x 31"
- Handles: 1" W cotton webbing – 1 ¼ yds.
- Bottom insert: 1 white corrugated plastic board
- Thread: colors that complement your fabrics and mesh
- **Clover Hot Ruler** – recommended, very helpful!
- **Sewing Machine**, manual, ¼" foot, universal foot, bobbins, and extension table (extension table is optional but very useful 😊)
- **Microtex needles:** 80/12 and 90/14
- **45mm rotary cutter** and cutting mat (18" x 24")
- **Acrylic Rulers:** 6" x 24", 6" x 12" and a "small" ruler –  
ex. 1" x 6" or 1" x 12" – *helpful with accuracy!*
- Sturdy pins, Wonder Clips (small, red) & a few longer green clips
- Blue painter's tape – a must have!
- Small iron and a wool mat
- Seam ripper, stiletto, tweezers, and any other favorite notions!

### Prior to Class:

Iron all of your fabrics...use Best Press or equivalent for best results.  
Bring lunch/snack for a full, fun day of sewing!
