Supplies for Class: The Supply List below supports the quantities of Fabrics to support the **Tripping Out** store sample quilt. The list in the pattern book will explain the fabric requirements for the size quilt (64" x 84") we are making.

Pattern: Tripping Out by Sew Kind of Wonderful

- **Fabric** (use non-directional print fabrics). A list of fabric requirements can be found on the back of the pattern. You may select your own fabric choice or use the color chart on the back of the pattern. All fabric I used was purchased at Scrap & Sew.

*****Required Tool: QUICK STRAIGHT RULER** which may be purchased in the store with your 10% class discount.

Clover Chaco liner pen or similar

Thread

Clover Wonder Clips

Sewing Machine in good working order with power cord and foot pedal

1/4" foot

Microtex 80/12 needle

Rotary Cutter (size 45mm)

Acrylic rulers including a 6" x 24" and cutting mat

Scissors, Seam Ripper, and any other usual sewing notions

Cutting Mat

IMPORTANT PREPARATION FOR CLASS:

1. READ all pattern instructions.
2. Prepare your fabrics. I did not wash my fabrics, but ironed with a mixture of Terial Magic and Best Press. You will get better and more accurate angles using these products. LABEL all your fabric according to the chart on page 1.
3. **Cutting will be done in class.**

Most of the first day, will be spent on cutting using the QUICK STRAIGHT RULER and organizing pieces. We will be sewing some of the afternoon and I will demonstrate how the pieces go together. You will notice 2 weeks between classes. Yup...that means a lot of homework. Second class day we will spend on putting the quilt together. LOTS OF SEWING!
