

## Sampler Skill Builder Supplies

Patsy Mosby

**Supplies:** Available at Quilters Crossing\*items have proven to work well

Book: Alex Anderson's Start Quilting, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition

Rotary cutter...\*recommended: 45mm with retractable blade

Rotary ruler...\*recommended: 6"X12", Creative Grids

Rotary mat...\*recommended: medium size, approx. 18"X24"

(Rotary tools are suggestions. If you have comparable sizes, bring them.)

Fine piecing or patchwork pins, \*Clover extra fine

Thread, 100% cotton, 50 wt., neutral color. \*Masterpiece or Aurifil

6 ½" square ruler                      6 ½" metal dressmakers sewing gauge (optional)

Post-it-Notes    Pen/pencil for Notetaking    Fabric marking pen \* Frixion

Basic sewing supplies: pincushion, scissors, seam ripper, box to organize.

**Fabrics:** For quilt top, choose fabrics listed on p. 41.

Making just the blocks? Omit backing, borders and binding, and select 1/3 yd. of focus fabric, and ¼ yd. each: 2 neutrals and 6 others (light, medium and dark). NO FAT QUARTERS!

**Sewing machine:** Make sure it is in good working order and you are familiar with operating it. Bring power cord, foot control and instruction book.

Practice stitching.

A week before class, you'll get an email with detailed instructions for pre-class prep.
