Serger with all accessories, oil, cord, and manual. Please make sure your serger is in working order. If not, please have it serviced and cleaned. This can be done at Quilters Crossing by their technician or another service location. Machines that have been sitting for a long time without use need to be maintained as they dry out and no longer function properly.

You will learn how to thread your machine and learn different techniques that can be done on the serger.

We will start a Serger Stitch Book with samples of the different stitches and tension settings so that you can refer back to it when you need information on how to do a stitch.
