QUILTY LADY

1. **Fabric**– About 5 fat quarters of a variety of fabric is approximately the amount you will need PLUS skin fat quarter.
BEFORE CLASS from the 5 fat quarters
Cut two 4" x 8" pieces for the **legs** and
Cut one 6" x 18" for the **sleeves** (yes just one)
Cut 128 (at least) 1 ½" squares for the **body** of your Lady
2. **Light weight iron on fusible** - 9" x 12" at least
3. **Tulle** – 24" x 4" color so you see it on top of the dress fabric
4. **Thread** – matching skin & blending with fabrics
5. **Floral Wire** – I will supply for you
6. **Poker** – Crochet hook or any tool to push the stuffing in the body.... Dull wooden pencil works fine
7. **Yarn** – This is her hair. I buy a skein of what goes with the fabric my Quilty Lady will wear. Buy new or bring from home. I buy hair at Hobby Lobby.
8. **Plastic Pellets** – We will use ½ -1 cup to weight the LADY'S bottom down so she sits properly.
9. **Stuffing** – the amount you can stuff in a 1 gallon zip-Loc and zip it shut
10. **Embellishments** - Optional *Anything you think might work – lace, buttons, beads, hair ribbon, tiny hair clip, etc.
11. **Scissor** – paper & fabric
12. **Hand Sewing Supplies** – to sew hair to head, include strong pins & sewing needle
13. **Sewing Machine** & typical sewing supplies, include strong sharp machine needle
14. **Irons & cutting mats** are in the classroom but... Bring what you usually like to use in class.
