



## Twinkle Star

### Supplies:

**Pre-Class Instructions – Twinkle Star – Print date: 09-08-17 (on back page)** – Pre-cutting the fabrics is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this course. Please begin preparing for class at least 2-WEEKS prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get familiar with your pattern and complete the pre-cutting beforehand. We always recommend reading through your entire pattern several times before beginning.

**Fabric Selection:** Please refer to the yardage chart on the back of your pattern for the required fabric amounts – this chart doesn't have it broken down but is using the colors in the picture. There is a picture of the design on page 15 that will aid you in picking out your fabrics for EACH section. They are assigned by letter and number. You can then go to the pages to see the breakdown even further... example... the lone star is for the S1-S9 fabrics... if you go to page 4, B sections are on Page 8 and C sections are on page 11, it tells you how much you will need for each of the S\* sections. You should label each fabric and also make a 'sample swatch sheet' by writing down each letter and putting a sample of the fabric next to it... taping it to the paper.

**Preparing your Foundation Papers:** Please read and follow the instructions for 'Foundation Papers, Templates and Template Layout Sheets' at the end of page 2/half way down 1<sup>st</sup> column of your pattern.

**Foundation Papers:** These are the foundations that you will sew the fabric directly onto. These need to be trimmed leaving a 1/8" border. DO NOT cut the individual units apart.

**Template Layout Sheets:** The template layout sheets are used to cut your fabric. You will cut through these templates when you cut certain parts of your fabric. These need to be trimmed leaving a 1/16" border and used per the directions in the pattern.

**Templates:** These are cut out of newsprint, freezer paper and/or template plastic and assist in cutting fabric in a specific shape. Check pattern for specific directions.

**Cutting Instructions:**

Please come to class with the following cut:

Fabric S1-S9 – all cut into a 2 ½” strip - these should be placed into a Gallon size Ziploc Storage Bag labeled A . Also in that bag will be the foundation Papers SS1, SS2, SS3 (see chart bottom of page 4) .

Fabric B1, B2, B3 - following pages 8 & 9 – Unit B cutting Instructions, Bag #B1

Fabric C – Page 11 Units CR1, CL1, CR2 and CL2 – cutting instructions Bags #CR1, #CL1, #CR2, #CL2

Sewing Machine with a quarter-inch foot and accessories

A piece of Template Plastic (3” x 12”)

12” Add-a-quarter ruler

Purple Thang (optional)

6” x 12” ruler

Medium size cutting mat (18” x 24”)

Rotary cutter 45mm or 60 mm

New rotary blade

Size 70 needles.

Scissors

Seam ripper

Fabric glue (UHU)

Glue Pen (Fons & Porter, Sewline or Avery)

High quality cotton sewing thread – (We like Aurfil thread)

Flower pins

Scotch Tape

Large Ziploc Bags

Binder Clips

Large Paper Clips
