

Reptiles and Frogs Fabric Collage

Material List Jane Haworth

A variety of plain and patterned pieces of fabric in rich colors suitable for a frog or reptile patterns. Hand dyes, batiks, Kaffe, small scale prints, textures are good. Colors to match your photo if bringing own photo. You only need small pieces, scraps work great, sharing and community fabrics are fun. Bring a variety especially if choosing the pattern at the class.

Larger piece of fabric for background 3/4- 1 yard. Sometimes easier to choose this when the collage is complete.

½ yard of Pellon 830 Easy Pattern, or a similar lightweight stabilizer that you can see through.

You can bring your own photo for a color guide to work with my pattern, bring 8 x 10" color enlargement.

Aleene's Tacky Glue or fabric glue or small glue bottle with needle applicator

Small container to hold glue and glue spreader. [I do sell these for \$1]
Toothpick, or coffee stirrer works

Fabric scissors and good small sharp scissors for cutting fabric. I use Karen Kay Buckley 6" perfect scissors.

Pencil

Chalk marking pencil or tool. I like the Bohin chalk pencil

Optional: Tweezers. Light box or pad. Painters tape, I will have some available.
