
Backing Tips

- □ We will choose a thread for the back of your quilt that <u>matches your top thread choice</u> in order to avoid "pokies" showing on the top or bottom of the quilt. Keep this in mind when choosing your quilt backing.
- □ We cannot center seams, motifs, labels, or blocks on the backing. It's best to piece backings off-center to avoid wear and tear on backing seams when the quilt is folded for storage.
- ☐ If your backing is extremely oversized, we will position the quilt top to leave the most usable fabric. The backing may also be trimmed before quilting.
- □ VERY IMPORTANT: Ensure that the seams in your pieced backing are not positioned so that they end up in your binding and will be least 4"- 6" from the edge of the finished quilt.



Additional Services

See the following table for additional services. Binding services are available for an additional fee and include trimming the quilt top and preparing the binding. You provide the binding fabric. Note that adding these additional services may increase turn-around time.

Pricing:

Edge to Edge Machine Quilting* Single pattern; includes thread.	\$0.03 per square inch (width x length x .03)
Batting	\$1.00 off per yard for longarm customers (or you can provide your own unpieced, non-wool batting)
Trim Quilt or Piece Backing	\$20
Binding (Includes trimming quilt top and binding preparation.)	\$0.45 per linear inch Machine sewn to back, brought around to front, and sewn down with matching thread. (perimeter x .45) or \$0.25 per linear inch Machine sewn to front only. You bring around to back and hand-sew to finish.
Minimum Fee	\$55

*Note: An additional \$60 surcharge will be added to the work order estimate for T-shirt, applique, or other quilts that may require additional attention during the quilting process. All or a portion of this fee may be added to the final cost depending on the amount of additional work required if fusibles used cause skipped stitches or other problems. To avoid surcharges or unquiltable tops, we strongly recommend that you only use high-quality, newly purchased fusible products in your quilt tops. Bargain fusibles and those that are old tend to cause issues.

Quilting Services

Edge to Edge Machine Quilting

Our longarm quilting services are completed on "Sewfie" our Gammill Optimum longarm machine with Statler Stitcher. The Statler Stitcher utilizes computer hardware and a software program called Creative Studio to guide "Sewfie" in creating state of the art stitching with design precision. We offer Edge to Edge (E2E...also known as Pantograph) services only. E2E is a single pattern stitched from edge to edge in a number of interlocking rows to cover the entire quilt top.

Checking In Your Quilt

- ☐ First, email the shop at: info@thegranaryquilts.com and ask for the Longarm Work Order Form.
- ☐ We will send you the form, the approimate turn-around time and other important information.
- Please review all information and ensure that your quilt top and backing are prepared properly.
- □ Completely fill out the form and sign.
- Drop-off your form, quilt top, and backing during open shop hours.
 NOTE: When dropping off your quilt, you will be required to leave a credit card number to be charged. Your credit card may be charged a few days before your quilt is completed.

Pricing

The price for quilting is determined by size of your quilt top in square inches. Measure the width and the length and multiply those two numbers to get the total square inches. If your quilt top measures 60" x 70" then your quilt is 4,200 square inches. At our rate of \$.03 per square inch, your quilting cost would be \$126.00. This cost includes thread. **NOTE:** Our minimum longarm fee is \$55.

For an additional fee we will piece backing, trim the guilt, and bind.

Note that a \$60 surcharge will be added to the cost estimate on the work order for T-shirt and machine appliqued quilts with fusibles (see reverse for details).

Batting

On the roll, we offer Warm & Natural 100% cotton, Hobbs Heirloom 80% Cotton/20% Polyester, Kyoto 50% Bamboo/50% Cotton, Quilter's Dream Select 100% cotton and Quilter's Dream 100% Wool batting. We also have a wide variety of packaged batting. Or, you may provide your own **unpieced**, non-wool, batting. We do not longarm quilts without quilt batting between the top and backing.

Preparing Your Quilt Top & Backing

Our goal is to provide excellent service with a quick turn-around time. In order to do that you are responsible for ensuing that your quilt and backing are prepared properly. Should we determine your quilt is not quiltable we will return your quilt to you to make the necessary adjustments. Please refer to the following checklist before checking in your quilt.

secure, and pressed open or to one side.
If you have a quilt top with bias edges or "piano keys" on the border, staystitch the outer border.
Clip all threads on the front and back of the quilt top (we are not responsible for threads on the back that may show through after quilting).
Label the top and bottom of the quilt and backing if it's directional.
Your quilt top MUST be square and lay flat. Measure your quilt across the top, bottom, and at the center. If the outer edge is more than an inch or two bigger, you will have wavy borders which can result in puckers in your finished quilt. If your top is not flat, we will contact you to determine if you'd like to fix it. If you choose not to fix it we will not guarantee there won't be puckers or tucks.
Remove all pins, embellishments, etc.
Backing (and batting) must be squared and 8" larger, in both directions, than the quilt top.
If your backing is pieced, use 1/2" seam allowances and press open. Refer to the diagram on the next page for pieced backing tips.
We only accept Shannon Cuddle brand Minky fabric. We will not quilt bargain-brand Minky fabrics.
We do not accept sheets, fur, fleece, or blankets as backings or batting.
We do not quilt double-sided quilts.
