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Sterling Quilt Class **With Julie Cefalu**

In this class you'll learn our favorite techniques for making half-square triangles and easy stitch & flip corners. The Sterling quilt pattern includes directions for three sizes; crib: 39" x 49", throw: 49" x 60", or queen: 87" x 97". Choose the size quilt you want to make and we'll help you pick your fabric. By the end of the class, you'll have completed one quilt block and be on your way to a beautiful finish! You can purchase a fabric kit for a crib size quilt; refer to the class description on the website to purchase.

Required Supplies:

- Sterling Quilt Pattern by The Crafty Quilter Designs (included in your class fee)
- Fabric: requirements as shown on the pattern (depending on the quilt size you choose) or a Sterling fabric kit purchased from The Granary
- 6 1/2" square ruler by Creative Grids
- Frixion Pen or other fabric marking tool
- Cotton thread in a neutral color
- Rotary cutter
- General sewing notions (seam ripper, scissors, pins, etc.)
- Sewing machine in good working order, or you can use a shop machine

Class Preparation:

- Cutting **some** of your fabric ahead of time will give us time to focus on techniques and get one block completed. Refer to the pattern and cut the following:
 - o Color 1(white): Cut (1) 3 1/2" x 42" strip. Subcut into four 3 1/2" B squares
 - o Color 3 (block center): Cut (1) 3 1/2" D square
 - o Color 4 (star points): Cut (1) 2" x 42" strip. Subcut into eight 2" E squares
- Please bring ALL of your fabric for the quilt to class.
