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## **Franklin Star – Julie Cefalu**

In this class, we will be making a 20 ½” square quilt block, that is the “star” of this quilt pattern. You will learn precision piecing techniques, how to match angled seams, and how to use the *Triangle in a Square Ruler*. ### **Supply List:**

**Required Pattern:** *Franklin Star Quilt* by *Julie Cefalu*

**Required Supplies:** *Small Triangle in a Square Ruler* by *Quilt in a Day*

### **Required Basic Sewing Supplies:**

- Sewing machine in good working order that you know how to operate; Sewing machine needles
- 1/4” foot for you sewing machine
- Scissors and Rotary cutter
- 6” x 12” ruler or larger and 6-1/2” x 6-1/” ruler or larger (optional)
- Pins, Seam Ripper,
- Marking tool such as a Frixion pen
- Piecing thread, neutral color

**Fabric Requirements:** See back of pattern.

### **BEFORE CLASS:**

In order to make the best use of class time, you will need to do some pre-cutting at home. Please cut one group of fabric (background, light, medium and dark) per the cutting instructions on page 3. This will give you enough to make 3 blocks, although we’ll only be using enough for 1 block in class.
