Half Yard Placemats (Mexican Tiles) – Candy Mah

Required Pattern: *Six Halves Make a Whole** by *The Quilt Branch*

Required Supplies: *Clearly Perfect Angles (optional)*

Required Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine that you know how to operate with 1/4" quilting foot. Sewing machine needles.
- Scissors, rotary cutter, rotary cutting ruler
- Pins, seam ripper, scissors
- Thread to match fabrics.

Fabric Requirements: See the *Mexican Tiles* pattern in the book.

Six half yards – either 1 focal fabric and 5 coordinating fabrics or 3 lights and 3 darks.

Before Class:

Cut fabric according to the directions for the Mexican Tiles placemats. Label the pieces as you cut. Sort each color and place in a separate baggy.

➔ Important! Pay very close attention to the cutting diagram. Those squares are 2-3/4" squares (not 2-1/4").
