


## Backing Tips

- ❑ We will choose a thread for the back of your quilt that matches your top thread choice in order to avoid “pokies” showing on the top or bottom of the quilt. Keep this in mind when choosing your quilt backing.
- ❑ When piecing your backing keep in mind that we cannot center seams, so it’s best to piece backings off-center.
- ❑ Ensure that the seams in your pieced backing are not positioned so that they end up in your binding.
- ❑ If your backing is extremely oversized, we will position the quilt top to leave the most usable fabric. The backing may also be trimmed before quilting.



## Binding Services

We will bind your quilt for the fee of \$0.40 per linear inch (quilt perimeter x .40). This fee includes trimming the quilt and preparing the binding. You provide the binding fabric. Binding is applied by machine to the back of the quilt and brought to the front and sewn down by machine using matching thread. Adding binding services may increase turn-around time.

**\*Note:** An additional \$60 surcharge will be added to the work order estimate for T-shirt, applique, or other quilts that may require additional attention during the quilting process. All or a portion of this fee may be added to the final cost depending on the amount of additional work required.

## Quilting Services

### Edge to Edge Machine Quilting

Our longarm quilting services are completed on "Sewfie" our Gammill Optimum longarm machine with Statler Stitcher. The Statler Stitcher utilizes computer hardware and a software program called Creative Studio to guide "Sewfie" in creating state of the art stitching with design precision. We offer Edge to Edge (E2E...also known as Pantograph) services only. E2E is a single pattern stitched from edge to edge in a number of interlocking rows to cover the entire quilt top.

We have a wide selection of edge to edge quilting designs to choose from.

### Checking In Your Quilt

The Granary is a very busy place and therefore sometimes we don't have someone available to check-in quilts. Please consult the Longarm page on our website at [www.thegranaryquilts.com](http://www.thegranaryquilts.com) for possible check-in days. Please call the shop the day you wish to check-in your quilt to make sure someone will be available and the best time to come.

Checking in your quilt will take 15-20 minutes. During this time we will work with you to help you choose a quilting design, batting, and thread that will help to create your treasured quilt. A work order will be created for each quilt detailing the services. You must sign the work order and leave a credit card number to be charged.

### Pricing

The price for quilting your quilt is determined by size of your quilt top in square inches. Measure the width and the length and multiply those two numbers to get the total square inches. As an example, if your quilt top measures 60" x 70" then your quilt is 4,200 square inches. At our rate of \$.0275 per square inch, your quilting cost would be \$115.50. This cost includes thread. Our minimum longarm fee is \$50.

For an additional fee we will trim and square your quilt after it is quilted.

Please note that a \$60 surcharge will be added to the cost estimate on the work order for T-shirt quilts and machine appliqued quilts (see reverse for details).

### Batting

We offer Warm & Natural (100% cotton), Hobbs Heirloom 80/20, Quilter's Dream Select (100% cotton), and Quilter's Dream Wool batting. You will receive a \$1.00/yard discount on batting when using our Longarm services. Or, you may provide your own unpieced batting.

### Preparing Your Quilt Top & Backing

Our goal is to provide excellent service with a quick turn-around time. In order to do that you will be responsible for ensuring that your quilt and backing are prepared properly. Should we determine your quilt is not quiltable we will return your quilt to you to make the necessary adjustments. Please refer to the following checklist before checking in your quilt.

- Press your quilt top and backing. Check to make sure seams are sewn, secure, and pressed open or to one side.
- If you have a quilt top with bias edges or "piano keys" on the border, stay-stitch the outer border.
- Clip all threads on the front and back of the quilt top (threads on the back may show through after quilting).
- Label the top and bottom of the quilt and backing if it's directional.
- Your quilt top **MUST** be square and lay flat. Measure your quilt across the top, bottom, and at the center. If the outer edge is more than an inch or two bigger, you will have wavy borders which can result in puckers in your finished quilt. If your top is not flat, we will contact you to determine if you'd like to fix it. If you choose not to fix it we will not guarantee there won't be puckers or tucks.
- Remove all pins, embellishments, etc.
- Quilt top, backing, and batting must be brought in as separate layers.
- Batting & backing must be 8" larger, in both directions, than the quilt top and squared.
- If your backing is pieced, use 1/2" seam allowances and press open. Refer to the diagram on the next page for pieced backing tips. We will not guarantee that seams, blocks, or labels in the backing are centered on the finished quilt.
- We do not accept sheets as backings.
- We do not quilt double-sided T-shirt quilts.
