Resolution No. 2014-2-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOT SULPHUR SPRINGS, COLORADO, PROVIDING THAT THE APRIL 1, 2014, REGULAR TOWN ELECTION SHALL BE GOVERNED BY ARTICLE 10 OF TITLE 31 OF THE COLORADO REVISED STATUTES; DESIGNATING THE ELECTION OFFICIAL; DELEGATING TO THE TOWN CLERK THE AUTHORITY TO APPOINT JUDGES OF ELECTION FOR THE REGULAR ELECTION; AND SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE APPOINTED ELECTION JUDGES

WHEREAS, the Town of Hot Sulphur Springs, Colorado (the "Town"), is a municipal corporation duly organized and operating as a statutory municipality under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31-1-101(1)(a), C.R.S., April 1, 2014, is a regular Town election date under state law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to authorize the election to be governed by Article 10 of Title 31, C.R.S., to designate the election official, to delegate the authority to appoint election judges to the Town Clerk, and to set the compensation of the election judges; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. Section 31-10-401 requires the Town Board of Trustees to either: (1) appoint judges of election at least 15 days before each municipal election; or (2) delegate to the clerk of the municipality the authority and responsibility to appoint judges of election; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to delegate to the Town Clerk, as the designated election official for the April 1, 2014, regular biennial election, the authority and responsibility to appoint judges of election for such special election; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. Section 31-10-408 provides that the governing body shall determine the compensation of election judges; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to set the compensation of the election judges.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LOCHBUIE, WELD AND ADAMS COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Polling Place Election. The April 1, 2014, regular Town election shall be governed by Article 10 of Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes.

Section 3. The Town Board of Trustees delegates to the Town Clerk the authority and responsibility to appoint judges of election for the April 1, 2014, regular biennial election, and to assure (a) the issuance of appropriate certificates of appointment by the Clerk, (b) filing by such appointees of a form of acceptance of such appointment within seven days of the mailing of the certificate of appointment, and (c) the taking of an oath or affirmation by such election judges before votes are counted in the form required by C.R.S. Section 31-10-407.

Section 4. Pursuant to C.R.S. Section 31-10-408, each election judge shall receive for their service the amount of ten dollars (\$12) for each hour of service.

Section 5. This Resolution shall serve to set the content for the ballot question set forth herein and the ballot title for such question shall be the text of the question itself.

Section 6. The Designated Election Official and Town's Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and appropriate action to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution including all reasonable and necessary action to cause such approved ballot question to be printed and placed on the ballot for the election.

Section 7. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining issues of this Resolution.


Section 8. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption
