

Clue #1. Driftline

Cut it out. Cut from Width of Fabric (WOF)

Fabric -6 <i>shown Orange</i> Fabric -7 <i>shown Blue</i> From each fabric, Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip Set aside remaining fabric for future use	Fabric -4 <i>shown Red</i> Fabric -5 <i>shown Lime</i> Fabric -8 <i>shown Purple</i> From each fabric, Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips Set aside remaining fabric for future use	Fabric -2 <i>shown Lt. Gray</i> Cut (5) 4-1/2" strips into (36) 4-1/2" squares (5) 2-1/2" strips into (72) 2-1/2" squares (8) 1-1/2" strips Set aside remaining fabric for future use
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Put it together.

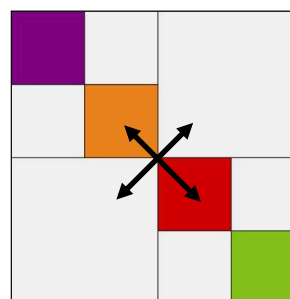
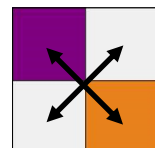
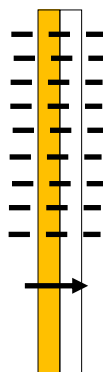
- Begin by pairing and strip stitching Block Fabrics-4/5/6/7/8 strips with Fabric-2 (1-1/2") strips. The unfinished strip set should measure 2-1/2" wide. Press toward Fabric-2. Sub-cut the pieced strips into 1-1/2"x2-1/2" units. Cut the following number of units.

Fabric-4 (36)	Fabric-6 (18)	Fabric-8 (36)
Fabric-5 (36)	Fabric-7 (18)	

- Select fabrics at random, and stitch units from Step 1 together matching center seam. Fan the seam or press the seam open. The unfinished unit (not yet set into the quilt) should measure 2-1/2" square. Make (72) units. Mix & match for a scrappy look, or establish a pattern—your choice. Both will look good in the quilt.

- Stitch a 2-1/2" Fabric-2 square to the side of the unit from Step 2. Press toward the Fabric-2 large square. The unfinished unit should measure 2-1/2"x4-1/2". Make (72) units.

- Stitch (2) units from Step 3 together, matching center seam. Fan the seam or press the seam open. The unfinished unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Make (36) units.



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5. Stitch a 4-1/2" Fabric-2 to the side of the unit from Step 4. Press toward the Fabric-2 unit. The unfinished unit should measure 4-1/2"x8-1/2". Make (36) units.



6. Rotate and stitch (2) units from Step 5 together, matching center seam. Fan the seam or press open. The unfinished unit should measure 8-1/2". Make (18) units.
