

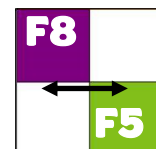
Clue #2. Riptide Pull

BEFORE YOU BEGIN: You will be constructing a square-in-a-square unit. Your retailer may recommend using a specific ruler. If you are using a special ruler, use the cutting Instructions with your ruler that will result in a 4" finished block.

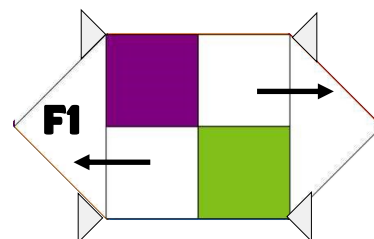
Cut it out. Cut from Width of Fabric (WOF) Set aside remaining fabric for future use.	Fabric -1 <i>shown White</i> Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, sub-cut into (11) 3-1/4" squares, cut twice, diagonally (2) 2-7/8" strips, sub-cut into (22) 2-7/8" squares, cut once, diagonally (2) 1-1/2" strips	Fabric -4 <i>shown Red</i> Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, sub-cut into (11) 2-7/8" squares, cut once, diagonally
Fabric -6 <i>shown Orange</i> Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, sub-cut into (6) 3-1/4" squares, cut twice, diagonally (1) 2-7/8" strip, sub-cut into (11) 2-7/8" squares, cut once, diagonally	Fabric -7 <i>shown Blue</i> Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, sub-cut into (6) 3-1/4" squares, cut twice, diagonally	Fabric-5 <i>shown Lime</i> Fabric -8 <i>shown Purple</i> from each fabric, Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip

Put it together.

- Follow the strip-piecing instructions from Clue #1 to construct (22) 2-1/2" four-patch units using **Fabric-1**, **Fabric 5**, and **Fabric-8** strips. Press ALL seams OPEN. The unfinished units should measure 2-1/2" square. Make (22) units.



- Use the units from Step 1 as the base of your square-in-a-square block. Begin by matching the center of the 3-1/4" **Fabric-1** quarter-square triangle (QST) with the center seam of the 4-patch unit. The corners of the QST will slightly overlap (approximately 3/8" the 4-patch. Stitch and press to the outside. Make (22) units.



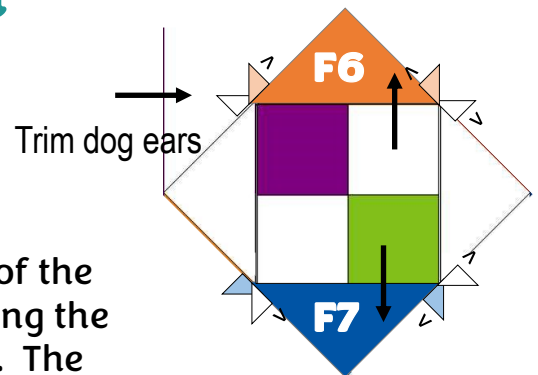
It is not necessary to trim the dog ears.



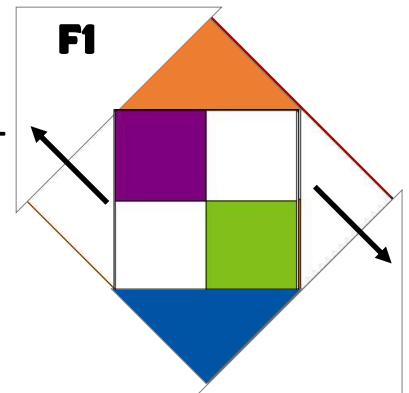

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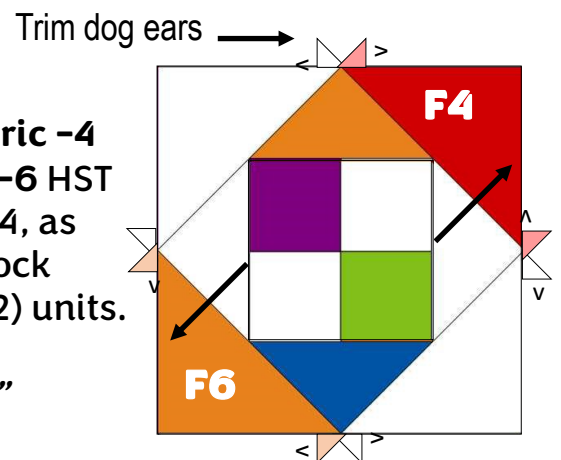
3. In the same way, stitch a 3-1/4" **Fabric-6** QST to the top and a 3-1/4" **Fabric-7** QST to the bottom of the unit from Step 2, matching centers and overlapping the outer points. Press to the outside. Trim dog ears. The unfinished square should measure approximately 3-3/8" square. Make (22) units.



4. Following the same method, stitch a 2-7/8" **Fabric-1** half-square triangle (HST) to the top-left corner and bottom-right corner of the unit from Step 3, as shown. Press to the outside. Make (22) units.



5. Following the same method, stitch a 2-7/8" **Fabric -4** HST to the top-right corner and a 2-7/8" **Fabric-6** HST to the bottom-left corner of the unit from Step 4, as shown. Press to the outside. The unfinished block should measure 4-1/2". Trim dog ears. Make (22) units.



Finished (sewn in the quilt) = block measures 4"
