

We will be making a Sew Together Bag by Sew Demented.

The Fabric Chic has a variety of kits to make this bag. You may purchase a kit or make your own fabric selections. The pattern is available separately in the store, as well.

You Will Need:

Sew Together Bag pattern

Fabric:

One fat quarter for the outer shell or a pieced fabric at least 13.5" x 9.75" (see note below regarding options for the outer shell)

One yard total for the inside of the bag and bindings:

- For the inside of the bag, you can choose to use one or more coordinating fabrics. I like to make a scrappy look by using a different fabric for each compartment and for the linings of the zippered pockets. I use another different one for the bindings. For a scrappy look, you can use 9 or 10 10" squares for the pockets and pocket lining. (half yard total)
- In addition, you will need a half yard, or two fat quarters for binding and the side panels.

Scraps of fabric to make zipper tabs for the inside zippers - you will need 6 pieces about 1.5" x 5".

If you would like to cut your fabric before the class, it will give you more time for putting the bag together. If you don't have time to do it before, you can do it during the class time.

You will need three 9" zippers, or longer zippers that can be shortened (recommended) for the inner compartments, and one 18" zipper or longer for the outside closure.

1 yard of lightweight fusible interfacing (I like SF101)

You will also need general sewing supplies such as a sewing machine with a zipper foot, thread, snips, rotary cutter, scissors, pins or wonder clips, seam ripper etc. A glue stick for glue-basting zippers is highly recommended! For finishing the binding by hand, you will need a hand sewing needle and a thimble.
