

Sedona Canyon Jacket Class

Welcome to wearable art !! You are going to make a quilt that you will be able to wear and show your creativity to all.

The pattern is included in the price of the class. After you sign up for the class, you can stop by the store and pick up your pattern. The pattern has the fabric and notions requirements. After getting your pattern - READ the whole pattern completely, even before buying your fabrics.

Below are some suggested substitutions for items on the Jacket pattern supply list. I've made these suggestions so that the jacket is wearable year-round. The changes will also help with the overall outcome of a successful and beautiful jacket.

- Use muslin (90-inch wide) for filling/batting layer
- Use 100% polyester lining instead of cotton – I prefer the “posh” lining, it is easier to handle and wears longer. Increase the amount of lining to 4 yards.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY: Wash, dry and lightly press your fabric (*except for the lining*) prior to class.

SUPPLY/TOOL LIST

The following supplies are required for the class:

- Sewing machine w/manual and accessories (don't forget foot control & power cord!)
- Extra Bobbins
- Extra Machine Needles
- Scissors – both fabric & paper
- Seam Ripper
- Straight Pins
- Rotary Cutter, Mat, and Ruler
- Freezer Paper
- Pencil & Eraser
- Paper for Notes
- Black Felt Tip Pen (e.g. “Sharpie”)
