

## Corner Beam & Sliver

Quilters will be preserving those crisp clean lines and points by oversizing the components of the Corner Beam. Trimming the unit to the final size with the guidelines provided on the tool ensures precision when combining these units with others. This one tool provides eleven different sizes for trimming.

The Corner Beam will add many unique options to your quilt designs. The combinations of twists and turns makes it look as if you had to work with lots of odd shaped pieces when in fact you didn't. The construction of a Sliver unit advances the use of the Corner Beam and once again makes precise piecing look so difficult! But now you know the key to success!

### Class Supplies

- Studio 180 Corner Beam - available for purchase from the instructor the day of class
- Technique Sheet: Sliver - available the day of class
- Design Sheet: Corner Beam - available the day of class
- Fabric for class - Please come to class with fabric cut into strips and squares per the table below.
- 6" x 24" Ruler, Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Sewing machine, Thread & bobbins, General sewing kit - scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
- Units created in previous Tucker University classes

### Pre-Class Cutting Instructions

WOF = width of fabric, approx. 40"

sq = square

Note: Cutting instructions are for a limited number of class samples.

I suggest using 'I wonder' (I wonder why I bought it) fabric to learn the techniques.

Fabric	Unit	Size	Quantity
Dark (Focus Fabric)	Squares for Corner Beam	5" x 5"	4 squares
	Squares for Sliver	5 1/2" x 5 1/2"	4 squares
Light (Background)	Strips for Corner Beam	5" x WOF	1 strip
	Squares for Sliver	5 1/2" x 5 1/2"	4 squares
Medium (Coordinating)	Strips for Corner Beam & Sliver	5" x WOF	1 strip
