

Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star
Advanced 1

Are you hooked on the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool? Now that you have mastered the basic construction of the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star you can expand your skills with three more options: Strip Pieced Lemoyne, Liberty Lemoyne and Banded Lemoyne.

This is one of the few Tucker University classes that has home work other than some pre-cutting. If possible, have the strip sets sewn together and pressed as specified. Also, please review the steps for a basic Lemoyne Star if you haven't made one in a while. Fair warning, put your thinking caps on for this class!



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Class Supplies

- Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool and Technique Sheets – available for purchase the day of class
- Design Sheet: Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Advanced 1 – available the day of class
- Fabric for class – Please come to class with fabric cut and sewn into strip sets per the instructions below.
- 6" x 24" Ruler, Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Sewing machine, Thread & bobbins, General sewing kit – scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
- Units created in previous Tucker University classes

Pre-Class Cutting & Sewing Instructions - label all fabrics and sub-assemblies!

Strip Pieced Lemoyne

- Fabric #1 – one 1 3/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric #2 – one 1 5/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric #3 – one 1 5/8" x 22" strip
- Fabric #4 – one 1 3/8" x 22" strip
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips

Sew Fabrics #1 & #2 together into a strip set
Press towards Fabric #1
Sew Fabrics #3 & #4 together into a strip set
Press towards Fabric #3

Liberty Lemoyne

- Fabric A – two 1 3/8" x 22" strips
- Fabric B – two 1 1/16" x 22" strips
- Fabric C – two 1 1/16" x 22" strips
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 22" strips

Create 2 identical strip sets: Sew with an A and a C on each side of a B. Press all seams towards A. Don't stress over the 1 1/16" strips, they just need to be a smidge over 1"

Banded Lemoyne

- Fabric X – one 1 3/4" x 22" strip
- Fabric Y – one 1 3/4" x 22" strip
- Fabric Z – four 1 1/4" x 22" strip
- Background Fabric – two 3 3/4" x 20" strips

Fabric Z is the 'band'. Fabrics X and Y can be the same fabrics or different fabrics. No need to sew anything for this technique. Just bring the fabric cut into strips.
