

Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Advanced 2

To finish up our Lemoyne Star madness, we're ready to tackle the last three special Lemoyne techniques – Fussy Cut Lemoynes, Blazing Lemoyne Stars, and Lemoynes as Triangles.

The Fussy Cut Lemoyne can feature fun fabrics, stripes or focus prints that can give your stars an additional design element. With just a simple modification, you can turn your Lemoyne Stars into triangles. The Blazing Lemoyne Star will give you four perfect diamonds within each star point. Switch the colors of the diamonds to get a variety of options.

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Class Supplies

- Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool and Technique Sheets – available for purchase the day of class
- Design Sheet: Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Advanced 2 – available the day of class
- Fabric for class – Please come to class with fabric cut per the instructions below
- 6" x 24" Ruler, Cutting Mat & Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Sewing machine, Thread & bobbins, General sewing kit – scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, etc.
- Units created in previous Tucker University classes

Pre-Class Cutting Instructions - label all fabrics

Fussy Cut Lemoyne

Background Fabric – 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" squares (cut 8)

For the star points, find a stripe (¼yard) or large print (½ yard) from your stash. We'll 'fussy' cut the fabric during class.

Blazing Lemoyne Star

Fabric A – one 1 ½" x 22" strip

Fabric B – one 1 ½" x 22" strip

Fabric C – two 1 ½" x 22" strips

Background Fabric – 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" squares (cut 8)

Lemoynes as Triangles

Fabric X – one 2 ½" x 22" strip AND one 3 ¾" x 22" strip

Fabric Y – one 2 ½" x 22" strip AND one 3 ¾" x 22" strip
