

We need N-95 mask covers. We are expecting the number of infected COVID-19 patients to rise this week. Community acquired transmission is just starting in San Antonio. By providing an N95 cloth mask cover, we are hoping to extend the integrity and protection of the N95 mask. It is critical that we protect our doctors and nurses so that they can outlive COVID-19 and continue to care for others with other ailments.

It is our goal to collect enough for all San Antonio healthcare workers who are on the frontlines of this epidemic. Below is a picture of the finished product. It fits easily over an N-95 mask.

Scroll down for the link to **Fitted Face Mask** and print the *Adult Male* template. The link is below the first diagram. Using this standard size will ensure that it fits over a standard sized N-95 mask.

A few notes:

The pattern shows 3/8" seam allowance, please ignore this and *use 1/4" seam allowance*.

Elastic smaller than 1/4" width is preferable.

Elastic should be cut to 8.5" and tied in a knot.

If you do not have elastic I can hopefully find some and add it after receiving your donation. If you have extra elastic, please consider donating it.
