

Stitch Adventure Class Policies

General:

- Class fees must be paid in full at the time of registration to reserve your spot. Space is reserved on first come first-serve basis.
- Supply lists will be given at the time of registration.
- Class fees are for instruction only and do not include materials for class, unless otherwise stated.
- Each student must have a LEGAL COPY of the pattern or book being used in the class. Due to copyright laws, we do require that the book or pattern for the class be purchased at Stitch Adventure as a requirement for participation. Stitch Adventure supports any and all efforts to be compliant with copyright laws and will not be party to or support anyone either knowingly or unknowingly breaking the law.
- Students are expected to purchase or bring hardware and basic supplies to class.

Sewing/Quilting:

- Students are required to bring a sewing machine in good working order, with the machine accessories. You should be familiar with the operation of your machine before class, please bring your manual if in doubt.
- Alternatively, a student may rent a sewing machine for \$25 per class session. In the event there is more than one session in a class, you will be charged for each class that you use the machine. If the machine is damaged or broken due to your negligence in the use of the rental machine, you will be required to pay for the full repair of the machine.
- Students are also required to bring basic sewing supplies to each class; unless otherwise stated. Basic sewing supplies include: 1/4inch foot, scissors, thread, seam ripper, marking pencil, rotary cutter and mat, rulers, etc.

Crochet/Knitting:

- Students are required to bring basic supplies to each class, unless otherwise stated. Basic crochet/knitting supplies include: circular knitting needles, crochet hook, tapestry/yarn needles, stitch markers, scissors, tape measure, etc.
- We are more than happy to help you in your selection of class materials, but please do so prior to class day or arrive 1 hour before class to make selections same day. For classes starting before store opening, your materials must be selected prior to the class date.
- We respectfully request class supplies be purchased at Stitch Adventure, so we may continue to bring you fun, innovative and exciting classes. We appreciate your support of our shop!
- Some classes require a small amount of homework prior to the class. Please arrive prepared so that you can start on the fun part right away!
- Class will start on time. Please arrive at least 15 minutes early for set up.
- If you bring your phone to class, put it on vibrate/silent prior to class.
- Please refrain from wearing perfumes, as some people have allergic reactions to scents. Also, if you bring a drink, please use a container with a lid.
- Children, visitors, and pets are not permitted in class.
- Please leave your work area clean when your class is finished.

Private Lessons:

- Our friendly educational staff is available to work on a private one-on-one basis or with small groups.
- Private lessons are an excellent opportunity for children, teens, and adults to learn exactly what they want to learn about sewing in a personalized environment.
- We are able to accommodate all skill sets from beginners to expert, and everything in between.
- Prepayment is required before a class is scheduled.

Cancellations/Refunds:

- Most classes have a minimum enrollment (usually 3 students). If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified and all course fees will be returned in full (your choice of a refund or store credit).
- If you cannot attend a course, please cancel at least one week in advance. A store credit will be issued ONLY if you cancel at least seven (7) days before the course. Cancellations within a week of the course will NOT receive a store credit, though you may send a friend in your place. Refunds will not be provided for no-shows.
- Workshops and other classes may be partially or fully non-refundable.
- There are no refunds on class fees for “Special Event” teachers/classes within 30 days of class date unless we can fill your spot with another person. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Please verify that any class you wish to enroll in meets your schedule and that you're OK with the cancellation policy before enrolling.

Skill Level Recommendations

Quilting Classes

- Novice - No quilting knowledge or skills needed.
- Beginner - Can thread the sewing machine, wind a bobbin, use a rotary cutter, & sew.
- Intermediate - Beginner level skills plus familiar with multiple quilting techniques.
- Advanced – Mastery of Beginner and Intermediate level, advanced techniques, able to troubleshoot quilting issues, quilts are square, deep understanding of color theory.
- All Levels - This class is of interest regardless of knitting skill levels.

Knitting Class

- Novice - No knitting knowledge or skills needed.
- Beginner - Confident with knitting basics and ready to go to the next level.
- Intermediate - Beginner level skills plus increase, decrease, and follow simple patterns.
- Advanced - Intermediate level skills plus yarn over patterns, cables, ribbing, comfortable with interpretation.
- All Levels - This class is of interest regardless of knitting skill levels.

Crochet Class

- Novice - No crochet knowledge or skills needed.
- Beginner - Can chain, single crochet, and double crochet
- Intermediate - Beginner skills, confident with crochet basics & ready to go to next level.
- Advanced - Intermediate level skills plus increase, decrease, and follow simple patterns.
- All levels - This class is of interest regardless of crochet skill.
