Learning Agreement with Texas Dive Center, Inc.

To learn and practice important concepts and skills for using life-support equipment underwater, you must invest the time needed to do it. This learning agreement is between you (the student diver) and our instructional staff regarding our mutual responsibilities in this program.

Student Diver Responsibilities

I (student diver) agree to study independently (on-line or manual method) as specified by the instructor. In general, this means that before each practical (pool or open water) session, I will as a minimum:

- Complete the assigned knowledge development portion of the course, including:
 - Read the assigned Diver Course Training section(s) and complete any Quiz questions and watch any videos provided with the course material.
 - Complete the assigned Knowledge Review(s) for each section and have them reviewed by my instructor.
 - Complete the Final Exam(s) if any, reviewing the results with my instructor.
- Follow all course procedures as set forth by my instructor.
- Ask questions about anything not understood.
- Be on time and be prepared for each training session, including having proper diving equipment as outlined in the Texas Dive Center diver certification outline for fit and suitability.

If I do not follow the points above, I understand that I may need to reschedule sessions, and that I'm responsible for any additional costs related to this. In scheduling and determining additional costs, Texas Dive Center Inc agrees to give every reasonable consideration to unforeseen events, such as family emergencies.

Instructor/Staff Responsibilities

The course instructor and staff agree to:

1. Start the class as scheduled.
2. Provide a positive learning environment.
3. Answer your questions to the best of our ability.
4. Assist you through any course challenges.
5. Provide opportunities for as many knowledge development, confined water dives and open water dives as necessary for you to comfortably master course-performance objectives. The course fee is based on **a average**, and includes all knowledge development assessments and required dives by the course standards. Because people learn skills at different rates, the course is student-centered and performance-based, not time-based. Additional sessions may be needed for you to comfortably meet course objectives for certification. Additional water sessions required due to diver not meeting requirements for certification are billed at \$45 hour. The instructor has the authority to either: (1) not certify student for failing to meet requirements; (2) certify the student only as a lower diver lever if possible and feasible; or (3) certify the student as meeting all requirements for the certification being sought. We will not certify marginal students (those barely showing mastery of required skills).
