Journey to the mid-19th century and read Mrs. Miller's diary, as she tells the story of meeting young Ellie who just moved into the neighboring farm with her widower father. When Ellie shows interest in learning to piece quilt blocks, Mrs. Miller takes Ellie under her wing, and not only teaches her to piece, but helps her learn many other housekeeping skills she will need to know.

Every month, you'll join them in creating a beautiful variety of sampler blocks and read diary entries telling the story of their growing friendship.

Indigo blue and light quilts were so very popular in the 19th century and are still a classic today! The quilt features several gorgeous Indigo blue prints, as well as many other shades of blue, and a blend of lovely light prints that make the sampler blocks sparkle! It's sure to be a treasured guilt in your collection.

This 12-month program begins Saturday, May 18, 2019 and includes monthly patterns, a 4 ½" Easy Angle Ruler, and all the fabric to complete the 77" x 89" pieced top. Directions are also included for completing the Storyteller Bonus Quilt (24" x 24") using fabric leftover from the Mrs. Miller's Apprentice quilt.

We look forward to working with you to complete this beautiful guilt!

- Your \$25 deposit (due by May 1, 2019) and completed Registration Form secure your registration.
- \$29.95/month plus applicable sales tax for 12 months (Includes monthly patterns, 4 ½" Easy Angle Ruler and fabric for Mrs. Miller's Apprentice quilt top and binding.)
- You will receive \$25 Yadkin Valley Quilts Quilty Cash with your final (month 12) kit.
- Shipping Monthly Kits for our out-of-area participants will have a \$10 shipping fee added to the monthly charge (plus applicable sales tax). Kits will be shipped using the U.S. Postal Service Priority Mail.

Pickup/Shipping

- Monthly kits will be available for pick up on the 3rd Saturday of each month, beginning May 18, 2019, for in-studio participants. Kits for our out-of-area participants will be shipped the Monday following the 3rd Saturday of the month.
- Participants picking up their kits between the 3rd Saturday and the last day of the month have
 the option of paying by cash, check, or credit card. Kits not picked up by the end of the
 month will be charged to the participant's card on the last day of the month, and kits
 will be held for pick up.
- Participants opting to have their kits shipped each month will have their credit cards charged for the monthly fee plus shipping and applicable sales tax the week leading up to the 3rd Saturday of the month. Kits will be shipped the Monday after the 3rd Saturday.

Studio Time @ Yadkin Valley Quilts

- Block of the Month participants are welcome to bring machines and supplies and work on your BOM or other projects during normal studio hours on the 3rd Saturday of the month. Feel free to bring a lunch, or join us in ordering from one of the local restaurants.
- Join us for a free Open Sew time the 2nd & 4th Tuesdays and/or the 3rd Saturday of each month to work on your project. Come and go 10 am 6 pm. Feel free to bring a lunch, or join us in ordering from one of the local restaurants.
- Our 2nd & 4th Thursday evening UFO night meets 6 9 pm. Staff is available to assist with your projects as needed. The \$10 session fee includes pizza and a drink.
- For either studio time, please call ahead to ensure that we have space set up for you.

YVQ Block of the Month Guidelines

Welcome to Yadkin Valley Quilts Block of the Month Programs!

We love Block of the Month (BOM) programs! BOMs are a budget-friendly way to purchase the materials for a quilt using equal monthly payments. Additionally, each month's kit breaks the complete quilt down into easily-manageable sections so that you don't get overwhelmed. Not to mention, participants who opt to utilize our open sew times have the opportunity to meet and socialize with fellow participants.

Our goal is to offer BOMs throughout the year that provide you with the opportunity to experiment with a variety of techniques and styles of fabric. This may include traditional piecing, appliqué, and paper piecing using solids, reproductions, or modern fabrics.

Who Can Participate?

Our BOM programs are open to quilters residing in the United States. Local participants are considered our "in-studio" participants. Our "out-of-area" participants are individuals who register for our BOM programs and elect to have their kits shipped to them. At this time, we are unable to accommodate International participants.

Program Fees

Registration Fee

Each program has a \$25 non-refundable Registration Fee, then a fixed-rate monthly payment for the duration of the program. The payment of your Registration Fee, plus the submission of a completed Registration Form, confirms your interest in the program, as well as helps us to cover the initial costs of the patterns and fabrics needed. It also allows us to offer you the project at a reasonable monthly fee, without a large lump-sum charge at the end of the program for borders, binding, etc.

At the completion of the program, your \$25 Registration Fee will be refunded to you in the form of YVQ Quilty Cash.

Monthly Fee

Each month you will be charged a fixed monthly fee (plus applicable sales tax and shipping) for the duration of the program. Kits will be available for in-studio pick up the 3rd Saturday of each month.

In-studio participants have the option of paying by cash, check, or credit card at the time of pick up. Kits not picked up by the end of the month will be charged to the participant's credit card on the last day of the month.

Cards for out-of-area participants will be charged the week leading up to the 3rd Saturday of the month (i.e., the Monday through Friday prior to the 3rd Saturday).

Shipping

Out-of-area participants will be charged \$10 per month (plus applicable sales tax) in addition to the monthly program fee. Out-of-area kits will be shipped via USPS Priority Mail the Monday following the 3rd Saturday of the month.

Credit Card

We require a valid credit card number to be on file for each BOM participant. Unless other arrangements are made, your monthly fees will be billed to the credit or debit card provided on your Registration Form.

In the event that we are not able to charge your card, we will contact you to make other payment arrangements. Your kit will be held until payment is completed. Please contact us with updated information if you receive a new card or the expiration date changes to avoid delays in receiving your kit.

YVQ BOM Guidelines

When you register for our BOM programs, it is understood that you are registering for the entire program. We will abide by this policy and prepare a kit for you each month with the understanding that you will remain in the program for the duration.

Cancellations

We understand that sometimes "life" happens! Should something happen that results in you needing to cancel the program, please let us know right away! If you must cancel prior to the conclusion of the program, the *Registration Fee is not refundable*.

Sometimes we provide complete products (patterns, tools, background, etc.) on our BOM programs during the first month. This is for your convenience and to protect against possible dye lot changes in the fabrics. In these cases, cancellations made by the customer will result in a fee for the full amount of the items (pattern, fabric, tools, etc.) received at the time of cancellation being charged to the credit card on file.

Mistakes?

Never fear! If you make a mistake on a particular piece of fabric, you may call and request a replacement. After fulfilling our kit requirements, we reserve any remaining fabric for the duration of the program for just this purpose. Give us a call and we will work with you to resolve the issue.

Reasons to Participate

Why should you participate in a BOM from Yadkin Valley Quilts?

Bring on the Fun! We do the hard part, and leave the fun for you! We work closely with our vendors to find and select beautiful programs, order the patterns, tools, and all the fabric necessary to complete the program, and offer them in monthly kits for easy use. We do all the legwork and ultimately save you time and money. In the event that a fabric chosen for the program becomes unavailable, we will select an alternate that matches the original as closely as possible.

Support We "know" our programs and are available to assist you should you have any issue. Just stop in, give us a call, or email us and we will work with you to find a solution.

Each month, we offer a minimum of five times when you may bring your project into the shop and sew with other participants. We reserve our classroom space the $3^{\rm rd}$ Saturday of each month for our BOM participants to come and work on their projects. Then, every $2^{\rm nd}$ and $4^{\rm th}$ Tuesday our studio is open 10 am - 6 pm for Open Sew. And, finally, every $2^{\rm nd}$ and $4^{\rm th}$ Thursday we offer UFO night 6-9 pm, which includes pizza and a drink!

We also offer a Facebook group for each program that provides a social forum for feedback from fellow participants and our staff.

Minimal Monthly Investment Once your Registration Fee is paid, you pay a fixed monthly payment for the program, allowing you to purchase all the materials necessary to complete your quilt top without a large cost up front.

Limits & Cancellations

Participant Limits Most of our BOM programs require an order commitment months prior to the start of the program. We guestimate as best we can the number of participants who might be interested in registering for a program. Therefore, we must limit the number of spots available in the program. Should we have a greater number of participants interested than we initially committed for, we will offer the option of being placed on a waiting list. In the event that we are able to secure sufficient materials to accommodate those on the waiting list, we will add those individuals to the program.

Program Cancellations In the event that there is not enough response to a program, we will cancel it and notify you. You will be given the option of applying your paid Registration Fee as a store credit or as Registration for another program.
