Winterization Tips

With colder temperatures in the forecast, pipes can easily freeze and break, causing water leaks. Follow these five tips to help avoid costly water leaks:

1. Close up crawl spaces around your home.
2. Insulate pipes.
3. Set thermostats to at least 55 degrees.
4. Open cabinets underneath sinks to allow more heat to circulate the pipes.
5. Let your facets drip, especially overnight when temperatures are usually at their lowest.
