CITY OF LONGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 296

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING
SECTION 2-101, CODE OF THE
CITY OF LONGTON, AND A-
MENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTI-
CLE 1 OF SUCH CODE BY DE-
CLARING THE PRESENCE OF
CERTAIN LIVESTOCK WITHIN
THE CITY LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF LONGTON TO BE A
PUBLIC NUISANCE UNDER
CERTAIN CONDITIONS, PRO-
VIDING FOR REMOVAL OF
SAID LIVESTOCK AND PENAL-
TIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE
OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be It Ordained by the Governing
Body of the City of Longton, Kan-
sas;

2-107. (a.) That the raising, feed-
ing, grazing, confining or other
concentration of cattle, horses,
mules, burros, ponies, hogs, sheep,
goats or poultry within the cor-
porate limits of the City of Long-
ton, Kansas, is hereby declared
to be a public nuisance whenever

such activities are carried on in
such a manner as to be hazard-
ous to the health or safety of the
citizens of Longton, or whenever
such operations cause or contrib-
ute to odors, noise, unsanitary
drainage, flies or other insects,
or whenever such activities are
carried on within 25 feet of a
habitable residence.

(b.) Any citizen of legal age,
of the City of Longton, or the
Boards of Health of the City of
Longton, Elk County, Kansas, or
the State of Kansas may lodge a
complaint in writing to the City
Council of the City of Longton,
alleging that a violation of this
Ordinance has occurred and it
shall thereupon be the duty of
the City Council to promptly con-
duct an investigation. If it be de-
termined that a public nuisance
does exist, the City Council shall
be authorized to adopt a resolu-
tion declaring the matter com-
plained of to be a public nuisance
and ordering the owner thereof
to abate and remove such nuis-
ance in such time as may be
specified by the City Council.

2-108. In the event such nuisance
is not abated within the time spe-
cified by the City Council, then
the City Council may have said
nuisance removed as provided by
KSA 12-1641, the expense of which
removal shall be certified to the
tax rolls of Elk County and the
cost assessed against the owner
of the property. In addition, a
fine not to exceed \$2.00 per ani-
mal per day, may be assessed
against the owner of livestock lo-
cated within the city limits in vi-
olation of this ordinance.

Should any Court declare any
section, clause, or provision of
this Ordinance, to be invalid,
such decision shall affect only
such section, clause, or provision
