AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #309 AND ESTABLISHING A CURFEW FOR MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF LONGTON, KANSAS.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LONGTON, KANSAS.


SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for the parent or custodian of a minor child under the age of 18 to allow the said child to remain or loiter on any public street or public place within the City of Longton between the hours of 11 o'clock P.M. and 5 o'clock A.M.

SECTION 2. Remaining in and loitering as used herein shall be defined to exclude cases where the minor under 18 years of age is accompanied by a parent or custodian or his or her presence is connected with or required by some legitimate business or profession in which he is engaged.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper.
