

**Longton City Council Meeting**  
**Approved Minutes**

April 10, 2018 – 7:00PM

The meeting was open by Mayor Stephen Fielder at 7:00pm.

**Minutes:** J.Walker made a motion to accept the minutes from the March regular meeting. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Bills:** J.Walker made a motion to accept the March paid bills and April bills to be paid, as presented. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Public Forum:** Sandy Trigg reported that lift station D is backed up and has a broken lock that needs replaced. Bonnie will report this to Hank in the morning.

Cassie Whaley requested to adopt the dogs that are in the pound. Nina reported that today was the final day for the owner to claim them and she would be taking them to Sedan on Friday. Council agreed to allow Cassie Whaley to adopt the dogs.

Charlie Stroble, representing the Longton Fair Association, requested permission to tear down the old restrooms that sit next to the fair barn. Council approved of this. Charlie also would like to get some quotes for insurance on the fair buildings that are not currently covered. Bonnie will get quotes.

Brandon Whaley requested to use the property north of the baseball field to host a car show during the Free Fair. Council approved Brandon to use the property.

**CMB License:** R.Boetefuer made a motion to renew Longton Grocery's cereal malt beverage license. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Emergency Water Supply Plan:** J.Walker made a motion to renew the Emergency Water Supply Plan. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Resolution 2018-2:** J.Walker made a motion to approve Resolution No 2018-2 which pertains to an increase in residential trash rates. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Ordinance No. 437:** J.Walker made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 437 appointing Tom McRay as Public Officer and Enforcing Officer. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Budget Workshop:** R.Boetefuer made a motion to send Bonnie to the Budget Workshop in Wichita on May 24<sup>th</sup>. J.Walker seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Library Vacancy:** J.Walker made a motion to appoint Deb Kill to fill the vacancy on the Library board. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

**City Council Vacancy:** J.Walker made a motion to appoint Mark Ashenfelter to fill the vacancy on city council. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

**Wtr-Swr-Street Report:** Bonnie reported the water tower inspection was done on Monday. The report will be mailed to us. Bonnie is working on getting the insurance on the water tower contents reduced.

**Fire Dept Report:** Bonnie reported that Jason Clatt planned to make a lumber purchase to begin putting up walls in the fire station.

**Other Business:** J.Walker requested to use the park and rec fund for the Fall Festival this year.

R.Boetefuer made a motion to fund the Fall Festival out of the Park & Rec fund. T.McRay seconded. Carried 3-0.

Bonnie reported that the school is not doing a traditional community service day, therefore, it would be nice if Hank could take a day to offer help in loading up citizens trash/junk to haul to the dumpsters. Council approved for Hank to haul trash/junk that is put out by the road side. Cassie Whaley also offered to assist. Jennifer Walker reported that the first Longton Farmer's Market will be held on May 16<sup>th</sup>.
