ARTICLES 11-103A AND 11-103B CHAPTER XI, OF THE CITY CODE OF LONGTON, AMMENDING AND MAKING A PART SAID CODE THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATION:

11-103a. CITY WATER MANDATORY. It shall be mandatory for any occupied residence or business which is open to the general public, within the city limits of the City of Longton, to be connected to the municipal water system of the City of Longton. It shall, however, be permissible to use water from a well or cistern for agricultural purposes or for the watering of livestock.

11-103b. This amendment shall be effective upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
