

Longton City Council Meeting
Approved Minutes

January 9, 2018 – 7:00PM

The meeting was open by Vice-Mayor Jennifer Walker at 7:00pm.

Minutes: S.Ferguson made a motion to accept the minutes from the December regular meeting. T.McRay seconded. Carried 4-0.

Bills: S.Ferguson made a motion to accept the December paid bills and January bills to be paid, as presented. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 4-0.

Public Forum: Shari Kaminska shared that Cornejo is considering setting up a temporary asphalt plan in Elk County – nothing definitive at this point. Flora Fielder representing the Longton Senior Center requested financial assistance for the center. S.Ferguson made a motion to assist the Senior Center financially for a time-frame of six(6) months by waiving their water bill plus \$50.00/month for the 6 months. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 4-0.

GAAP Waiver: S.Ferguson made a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-1 which pertains to the GAAP Waiver. R.Boetefuer seconded. Carried 4-0.

Wtr-Swr-Street Report: Hank reported that the water pipes in A-Z Sales froze and broke causing the Post Office to be without water while repairs were made. Council asked Bonnie to contact the property owner of the Post Office to see about getting their own meter.

Fire Dept Report: Kimber reported she would be attending a seminar in Salina on January 20th. She reported there was minimal damage from a hit & run at the fire station – a report has been made to the Elk County Sheriff office. She also reported that the fire dept has entered into an agreement with Elk Valley School to use their frequency. Shari Kaminska noted that there is an upcoming Elk County commissioner special meeting to discuss options of building a new tower in the county.
