

ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO THE SOUTHERN KANSAS TELEPHONE COMPANY, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF LONGTON, KANSAS, SETTING FORTH CONDITIONS ACCOMPANYING THE GRANT OF FRANCHISE PROVIDING FOR CITY REGULATION AND USE OF THE CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

in the following terms, to-wit: to construct, operate, maintain and use a cable television system in the City of Longton, Kansas, for a term of twenty (20) years, commencing on the date of the grant of this franchise to the Southern Kansas Telephone Company, Inc., and its successors and assigns, and to provide for the regulation and use of the cable television system and to provide for the enforcement of the provisions of this ordinance.

- (1) "City" shall mean the City of Longton, Kansas, and shall include any public road, right of way, street, highway, alley, walk, bridge, canal, park, alley, canal, sidewalk, park way, drive, communication system, utility easement, by whatever name known, used or hereafter to be known, and all other public places.
- (2) "Company" shall mean all persons, domestic or foreign, organized by the laws of the State of Kansas or of any other State or Territory of the United States.
- (3) "CITY" shall mean the City of Longton, Kansas, as hereinafter defined.
- (4) "Cable Television System" shall mean any system consisting of wires, lines, cables, conduits, cables, lines, wires, or any other devices, or any combination thereof, used for the transmission of television signals.
