March 21st, 2019

- 1. Minutes of February Meeting:** Minutes were read over. Bryce made motion to accept the minutes, 2nd by Pam- all in favor.
- 2. Clerk Report:** Pam gave 2 positions open June 1st thru June 7th. Clerk position will stay on the council. Linda's position will be taken off the council and will keep employment.
- 3. February Receipts and expenses:** Linda went over these, Dallen made motion to accept the receipts and expenses, 2nd by Bryce- all in favor.
- 4. Water Department:** Dallen attended the water conference in St George last month. The Consumer confidence report will no longer be done by the division. Dallen has it done and will post @ post office- needs to be put on the water bills as well. 2019 will do tests on the well when it is turned on. Tests will be taken to SLC to Chem-tech. Dallen will check on Argelia's yoke. May also have a leak on 200 E on main line he will have Ivan help him check. Got approval for plan to replace valves. Curt from Ensign Engineering- Chlorinator approval received from division of drinking water. Need a contractor to do the work, Curt will help us find one. Ready to start the center upgrades as soon as the weather permits. Final completion in June. Well project is just about ready to submit and then a waiting period. Scholzen's will send a double bill for chlorinator rental.
- 5. Scouts:** Eagle Scout projects- Tree's in cemetery need to be removed. Cody Robison will take this project. Rider Monroe will help with the street signs and Burtis and Bryce will work with them.
- 6. Streets:** Kevin Rasmussen is here, crack seal is going good- they had to stop for weather but they made a list of pot holes and when they come to asphalt the center parking lot they will fill those pot holes too. Bryce would like to get a tractor for street mowing.
- 7. Land Use Authority:** No business at this time.

- 8. Fire Department:** Kevin Monroe is here to report from district meeting. The District will submit one report for all the small towns which Landon Rowley will do. Fireman association dues- the town will pay and the fire district will reimburse. Workman's comp – we do have the volunteer fire fighters covered. There is a training in May Kevin would like some to attend. There is a hole on the north end of the building that Pam would like Kevin to look at. Pam is concerned about the siren and how long it went off the other night. A new siren would be up to the town. We do have one of the larger sirens.
- 9. Rodeo Grounds:** The committee is going through the Eccles Foundation. They are looking for funding to match from the town, flying J, the committee, etc. They are most concerned about the arena dirt right now. The cost for that would be around \$55,000. Pam talked about CIB- \$100,000 to do underground sprinklers. The Rodeo would like to extend the bucking chutes. They would like the town to donate. Dallen made the motion to give \$5,500 2nd by Linda. Linda talked about the need for the rodeo committee to get TULIP Coverage for liability. She will send Terry the info.
- 10. Other:** Pam is checking into more street lights.
Talked about Rural online initiative in April.
Tree trimming will be taking place soon.
Egg Hunt will be April 20th. Linda will buy the stuff and the young men and women will help.
