November 14th, 2019

- 1. Minutes of October Meeting:** These were read out loud by Rebecca. Linda made a motion, 2nd by Dallen- all in favor.

 - 7. Acknowledge New Council Members:** Pam acknowledged and welcomed the two candidates that won at the November election. Casey Hatch and Jim Winget.
 - 8. New Council Positions:** Tabled until next month.
 - 9. Other:** The board will hold the Christmas Lights contest in town with water bill discount for the top three best decorated houses. Town will hold its first annual tree lighting ceremony on December 2nd We will serve hot chocolate and doughnuts, Starts at 6:00 pm
