

Quilter's Trek 2021 Fall Leaf Block Corrected Renee's House of Quilting 231–267–5895

Cutting instructions:

Background:

C = two 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

D = six 2 1/2" squares

E = one 2 1/2" squares

F = two 3 1/8" squares

G = two 2" square

Black grunge:

A = two 1" x 9 1/2" strips

B = two 1" x 8 1/2" strips

N = one 3 1/2" square

Turquoise Venice:

H = one 2 1/2"

square

I = one 2 " x 3 1/2"

rectangle

Red Venice:

J = two 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

Dark green:

K = one 2 1/2" square


Yellow Venice:

L = 21/2" x 31/2"

Green Venice:

M = two 2 1/2" x

3 1/2"



Instructions:

- 1. Use the sew and flip technique for the leaf points. To do this, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the D background squares. Place one square on the top right or top left corner of the J, L & M pieces, lining up the raw edges having right sides together. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Note the direction of the angle when sewing the D blocks to the corners. Repeat for the I/G section (save remaining 2" G square for corner of block.)
- 2. Make a 1 1/2" finished half square triangle E/H. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the E square. Place the E & H squares right sides together, stitch 1/4" on each side of this drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line, you will have one extra half square triangle.
