

Barcode Quilt

Here's a quick and easy pattern to create a quilt from a layer cake. Join Cheri to learn the construction details. This zero waste project makes a 52"x66" quilt. Class is limited to 4 to help us with our distancing. This is a perfect class for the confident beginner quilter.

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Supply List

- \Rightarrow 1 layer cake OR (42) 10" squares
- ⇒ Machine and basic supplies listed to the right.

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Marking pencil or fabric marking pen
- ⇒ Smaller ruler for marking
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
- ⇒ Pattern (received in class)
