

Disappearing Four Patch

Join Nancy as you make the Disappearing Four Patch block in this 3 hour class. This versatile block goes together quickly. Beginning to advance level quilters will enjoy this project!

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 4 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Supply List

- ⇒ 2 charm packs. One of focus fabric and one of background fabric
- ⇒ Rotary cutter
- ⇒ Ruler, at least 12 inches long
- ⇒ Cutting Mat, not required (Small- 12 to 18 inches or a rotating mat if you have one.)
- ⇒ $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot for sewing machine
- ⇒ Beginning quilters, please bring your machine manual!

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
- ⇒ Rotary Cutter

Homework: Look through your focus fabric charm pack. You will need 40. (There should be 42 in the pack.) Sort the 40 fabrics into pairs that are contrasting. Example- a floral with a stripe, or a solid with a polka dot, or a dark with a light. You will have 20 pair. Bring the extra 2 fabrics to class.
