



Herringbone Quilt Class

Monday April 25, 2022

9 am to 1 pm

Wonderful quilt for your summer fun! Join Nancy for a morning of sewing to get you started on this herringbone pattern, using 2 layer cakes. Good class for a confident beginner to intermediate quilter.

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 4 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Supply List

- ⇒ Layer Cake of color fabric
- ⇒ Layer Cake of background
- ⇒ Machine and basic supplies listed to the right
- ⇒ Rotary cutter and cutting ruler that is 12 inches or longer.
- ⇒ Optional: flannel backed tablecloth or flannel sheet to be used as a design wall.

If you cut your own layer cake, you will need $3 \frac{1}{4}$ yards of fabric, cut into (42) 10 inch squares.

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
- ⇒ Drink and snack
