

Introduction to Machine Applique

Join Donna to be introduced into the world of machine applique. You will learn how to use the blanket stitch on your machine to applique shapes. We will supply the KIT to get you started. You will leave with a cute bunny block that can be used to make a pillow or placemat/mug rug. 3 hours

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin have limited seats for participants. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. **Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable**.

Supply List

- ⇒ White thread
- \Rightarrow New sharp machine needle 80/12
- \Rightarrow Open Toe Foot
- ⇒ Machine and basic supplies listed to the right

Important: before signing up, check your machine manual and machine to make sure you have a blanket stitch AND open toe foot.

Kit includes Steam A Seam, stabilizer, shapes to applique and fabric to applique bunny.

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Marking pencil or fabric marking pen
- ⇒ Smaller ruler for marking
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
