



Jacob's Ladder Table Runner

Join Donna to make this cute block used to make a table runner. This runner could be a great gift, especially if made in holiday fabrics (such as Christmas, Patriotic, Halloween, etc).

Or choose your fabrics to match your décor.

Spend the 3 hour class learning the technique to make the Jacob's Ladder block. Four blocks will make the runner top.

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 4 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration or print at home. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Supply List

- ⇒ 2 Fat quarters: 1 for the accent (blue) and 1 for light colored background (white)
- ⇒ $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of dark fabric (red)
- ⇒ $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of border fabric
- ⇒ Rulers - 6" x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- ⇒ Optional rulers for squaring up half square triangles (example slotted trimmer)
- ⇒ Thread (use either white or gray)
- ⇒ Machine and basic supplies listed to the right.
- ⇒ Rotary cutter with sharp blade
- ⇒ Quarter inch presser foot
- ⇒ Pattern handout will be provided at class
- ⇒ Purchasing your supplies for this class at The Dancing Bobbin you will receive a 10% discount

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
- ⇒ Fabric marking pen
