



## Flip Flops Applique Table Runner

(~18" x 38")

How cute to decorate your table with a Flip Flop Table Runner. The flip flops are made from fabric scraps and applied on to the background. Great class for experienced beginners and seasoned sewists alike! 3 Hours.

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 6 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

### Supply List

- ❖ 1 yard for background fabric and outer border and binding
- ❖ 1/4 yard for inner border
- ❖ 6 - 5"x10" scrap fabric for shoe base
- ❖ 6- 4"x5" scrap fabric for thongs
- ❖ 3 or more fussy cut flowers for flip flops
- ❖ Thread to match shoes & thongs for appliqueing
- ❖ 1/3 yard of Steam n Seam
- ❖ Rotary cutter with sharp blade

### **CUT BEFORE CLASS:**

Cut background piece 12" x 32 1/2"

Cut 3 strips for inner border 3 WOF x 1 1/2"

Cut 3 strips for outside border 3 WOF x 3"

\*WOF = width of fabric

### Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ 1/4" foot if possible (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Open toe foot for applique stitching
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
