

Lolly Quilt

Make a quick and easy quilt using a jelly roll or layer cake. Spend an hour with Tracy learning how to put together this quick quilt and then stay as long as you like. Maybe even take home a finished top!

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 6 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Supply List

- ⇒ 1-2 jelly rolls or layer cakes (just depends on how large you want your quilt to be.)
- ⇒ Machine and basic supplies listed to the right.

Sort your strips or squares into coordinating pairs. Don't overthink it too much, they are all going together anyway. ③

Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒ Appropriate foot (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note taking
