



## Hidden Zipper Pillow

Turn a mini charm patchwork piece into a pillow cover featuring a hidden zipper! Great use of Mini Charms or even a Charm Pack. Stitch up some mini charms and then join Tracy to learn how to make a pillow cover with a hidden zipper closure. Great class for experienced beginners and seasoned sewists alike! 3 Hours.

Classes at The Dancing Bobbin are limited to 6 participants on a first come, first served basis. You may register in person at the shop or online. Unless specified, the cost for project supplies and/or kits is **not included** in the class fee. You will receive a supply list at the time of registration. Always bring your personal sewing machine, basic sewing supplies such as scissors, seam ripper, thread, extra machine needles, etc. and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to class time so you have ample time to set up before class begins. Remember that class fees are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

### Supply List

#### ❖ Fabric:

- ✂ **Front:** 81 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (2 mini charm packs are perfect!)
- ✂ **Batting:** 22+" square
- ✂ **Lining:** 22+" square muslin or scrap fabric (this will be inside your pillow - won't be seen)
- ✂ **Back:** 1/2 yard non-directional fabric **OR** 2/3 yard directional fabric

- ❖ 22" nylon zipper
- ❖ Coordinating thread for quilting
- ❖ Walking foot or free motion foot if possible
- ❖ New sewing machine needle and a spare in case of breakage
- ❖ Straight pins

#### Don't forget your...

- ⇒ Sewing machine
- ⇒ Power cord and foot pedal (it happens!)
- ⇒  $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot if possible (see class list for specific requirements if any)
- ⇒ Extra needles & bobbins
- ⇒ 50 wt Cotton thread
- ⇒ Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper
- ⇒ Pen and paper for note

### \* HOMEWORK \*

Prior to class, sew your 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 9x9 grid to be used as your pillow top!
